

Kalamazoo Rotary Club Membership Guidelines

Every Rotarian has the privilege and obligation to seek qualified new members. In this way, all club members can help the club achieve a full and diverse representation of the business and professional life of the community. Membership is the means to accomplish Rotary's mission and goals.

Prospective Kalamazoo Rotarians are adults of good character and good business or professional reputation. They are the established or emerging leaders of any recognized business or profession and have held a position of discretionary or management authority for at least two years or have retired from such a position.

Prospective Kalamazoo Rotarians should have a history of involvement in community service or a stated desire to become involved and are further committed to join and actively participate in at least one Kalamazoo Rotary Committee.

Prospective Kalamazoo Rotarians will be expected to make timely payment of annual dues and make annual voluntary charitable contributions to Kalamazoo Rotary Charities. Further, prospective Kalamazoo Rotarians should expect to make additional regular commitments of time and/or financial contributions to Rotary Foundation, Rotary International, and Kalamazoo Rotary projects and special fund raising efforts.

Prospective Kalamazoo Rotarians should reside or work in the Kalamazoo area for at least 6 months (not applicable to those who may transfer from another Rotary club) and must be committed to meeting club attendance requirements.
